PRESENTATION TO CLLR JOHN JONES FOR HIS ALL HIS WORK ON BEHALF OF THE PARISH

The Chairman thanked John for his work and presented him with a rose. John stated that he was always pleased to help and regretted that he had not been able to see through to a conclusion the situation with the Car Wash on the A38.

STROUD DISTRICT COUNCILLOR'S REPORT

Cllr Dave Mossman gave an update on the latest situation with the new GP surgery due to open late 2017/early 2018 at Kingsway and the planning situation at Mayo Fields and Cross Keys. He gave an explanation as to why Cotswold District Council leaving Gloucestershire County Council and going to Oxford County Council would be a bad thing for Gloucestershire, and the latest on the incinerator and its associated liaison groups. It was suggested that Moreton Valence join with Hardwicke and Whitminster to work together in the purchase of new Vehicle Registration Identification Cameras at a cost of £5,000 per camera. Cllr Lyn Bushell voiced frustration with the last volunteer scheme when the parish was promised speeding drivers would be contacted by the Police and then this did not happen. She was keen that the Parish gained firm reassurance that this would not happen again before entering into any similar schemes.
