PRECEPT JUSTIFICATION FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2018/19

On 25th January 2018 the Council set a budget of £7,212 and a precept of £5,500. This is an increase of £500 on the precept for 2017/18. The remaining money of £712 will be paid from reserves.

As part of the feedback through the Parish Plan that took place in 2013, concerns were raised as to the state of the pedestrian footpath along the A38, and ongoing road safety concerns. As a result, the Council has budgeted £2,000 towards projects that could alleviate these issues.

Other increases result from the need to comply with new Data Protection legislation, an increased grant to St Stephens PCC towards the upkeep of the Parish Church, as well as inflation expenses.

The Council feels that this increase is justified for the above projects to take place.
